The colt is out of Dun-Haven Phenomenal's mother, Dun-Haven So Lovely, and by the harness pony, WC Crystal Creek's Commander. We wanted "So Lovely" to have another foal but thought that she was getting too old. Drs. Baker worked tirelessly to do an embryo transfer out of her. They were successful and on October 7th, 2010 our first colt was born. A young maiden mare that the Bakers own was the surrogate mare. He should be home for everyone to see in March.
